### COVID-19 SPECIAL NOTICE (6)

It is with regret that a large number of persons have been seen walking, jogging and cycling on the golf course and Estate, despite the information contained in SPECIAL NOTICE (5).

We have now received official confirmation that the rules and laws apply to residential and security estates. The statement was published over the weekend and reads as follows:

*National police spokesman Brig Vish Naidoo said there had been several enquiries about residents being able to walk or jog within residential or security estates or within their complexes.  
The regulations also apply to people living within complexes/estates meaning no walking, jogging or walking of pets within closed estates/complexes will be allowed, read a statement from Naidoo.  
All complex/estate managers must assist by ensuring these regulations are enforced with immediate effect.*

Please be advised that any further non-compliance of this ruling, after 16:00 this afternoon, will be noted and passed on to SAPS in Kleinmond.
